



Health Protocol Policy

Where a staff member has a reason to believe that a student or a staff member is infected with a notifiable communicable disease as defined by the Sections 22(1) and 26 of the Alberta Public Health Act, he/she must immediately notify administration staff, a designated first aid responder(s) who will have access to the records of the pre-existing health conditions of students and staff. The administration staff shall notify the Alberta Health Services Medical Officer for the school Zone. The principal of the school has the right and authority to send a student or fellow coworker home if they are compromised with sickness that is prohibiting their ability to perform their regular responsibilities.

- (a) By the fastest means possible in the case of a prescribed disease that is designated in the regulations as requiring immediate notification, or
- (b) Within 48 hours in the prescribed form in the case of any other prescribed disease.
